## DEAD BABY

# Four days pass as heartbroken mother awaits answers

# Shattered

MEI Zhen Lin is heartbroken she could not cradle her toddler son when he called out for her, minutes before he died at Ba Mission Hospital last Thursday night.

The Chinese national and her husband, Jinda Peng, are now seeking answers as to what caused the death of their only child, 18-month-old Hao Yuan Peng.

"Four days have passed since my baby died and the hospital has not answered

my one question," she claimed yesterday.

"I want to know what injection they gave him. I asked both hospitals for his medical records and they won't give it."

The 46-year-old said the toddler was taken to Ba Mission Hospital on Thurs-

day morning because he had a fever.

She claimed that doctors then referred baby Hao to Lautoka Hospital where he underwent blood and urine tests.
